The Quarterly OPEB Trust Committee was held on August 20, 2024. The committee was told that AON could not compare other Medicare Advantage plans for retirees over 65. The committee would be required to develop a scope of work if the committee approves moving forward with a Request for Proposal (RFP). The current contract for the Anthem Medicare Advantage plan is up for renewal for calendar year 2025 and requires the committee to approve moving forward for an additional year. A motion was made and then amended to continue with the current Anthem Medicare Advantage plan for one

additional calendar year and to work to create an RFP for calendar year 2026. The amended motion was seconded and passed unanimously. Senate Joint Resolution (SJR) 179 and the impact any recommendations may have on the OPEB Trust was discussed. System office staff will work with AON to run scenarios on any recommendations from SJR 179. The committee is interested in receiving fiduciary training on the trust from AON and will set up a training session with AON.
