



TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE

Associates in Arts to Bachelor of Science, Liberal Arts & Science

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for Associates in Arts at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to the Bachelor of Science, Liberal Arts & Sciences at Campbellsville University.

Admission Requirements

To apply to Campbellsville's liberal arts and sciences degree, prospective students must complete the following steps:

1. Complete the [CU online application](#).
2. Submit official copies of transcripts from each college or university previously or currently attended, along with a complete record of all courses attempted, to the Office of Admissions.
3. If transferring less than 24 credit hours, submit official high school transcript.

Graduation Requirements

A candidate for a degree must meet the following requirements for graduation:

1. All candidates must complete a minimum of 120 semester hours of academic work with a minimum standing of 2.10 in the area of concentration, or in majors and minors, and a minimum overall average of 2.0. "D" grades are not acceptable in [ENG 111](#) or [ENG 112](#) or their [KCTCS equivalents](#). No "D" grade is accepted on area or major and minor programs unless approved by the division chair.
2. Students seeking teacher certification must have an overall 2.75 cumulative grade point average.
3. All candidates must have completed all general education requirements.
4. All candidates must have completed one major and one minor or an area as specified by the Division or School applicable in each case. In combination, a major and minor must total 51 hours, exclusive of courses in methods.
5. All candidates must complete a minimum of 42 semester hours of credit in courses numbered 300 or above, and also, complete a minimum of 25 percent of the requirements for graduation at Campbellsville University.
6. All candidates must submit a Graduation Application on TigerNet.
7. At least one-third of the course requirements in the major and in the minor or area of concentration must be completed at Campbellsville University with an average of "C" or better.
8. All candidates for a degree must complete the last 30 hours of credit in residence.
9. No more than 32 hours of correspondence and/or extension work will be accepted for credit toward the degree. No student may enroll for correspondence or extension while doing resident

work without permission of the Registrar. Correspondence work in major or minor field must be approved also by the Chair of the Divisions concerned.

10. The student must, in all cases, be responsible for meeting the requirements for graduation.

11. All candidates must fulfill Chapel/Convocation Program credit requirements. (Online Students are Exempt)

Degree Requirements

General Education Requirements: 41 Hours

Concentration Area: 21 Hours

Free Electives: 58 Hours

Students will choose from one of the concentration areas below and complete the courses required for that area.

General Transfer Requirements

Transfers from KCTCS are eligible for the following scholarships

- Online Students-up to \$1500
- Regional Sites-\$500 Opportunity Scholarship
- Main Campus- \$6000-\$900 Transfer Scholarship

Degree Requirements for KCTCS

1) Completion of minimum 60 credit hours, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) minimum of 15 credit hours earned at the institution awarding the degree, 4) cultural studies course, 5) demonstration of digital literacy, and 6) college success requirement.

Individualized Studies Concentration:

Designed concentration areas must be approved by either the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences (for students pursuing the program on-campus) or the Dean of Regional Instruction (for students pursuing the program at regional centers) or the Vice President for Academic Affairs.

Choose seven courses, 3 courses must be upper division: 21 Hours

Electives: 58 Hours

Choose any courses from any college or school that are not used to meet other program requirements. Of the 58 hours, 33 hours must be upper division (level 300-400).

Free Electives to reach 120 hours: 58
