



TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2019-2020

Associate in Applied Science in Criminal Justice to Bachelor of Arts in Criminology & Criminal Justice

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate in Applied Science in Criminal Justice at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to the Bachelor of Arts in Criminology & Criminal Justice at Morehead State University.

Applying to the KCTCS2MSU Program

Students can apply to participate in the pathway program by completing the online application on the [MSU transfer webpage](#). Students must be enrolled in at least six credit hours at their KCTCS institution, enrolled in an associate degree program, plan to transfer to MSU, and maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA at their KCTCS institution.

Admission Requirement to MSU

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into MSU.

Degree Requirement for MSU

To earn a bachelor's degree at MSU, students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours with at least 42 credit hours numbered 300 or above. In addition, at least 32 credit hours at MSU with the last 16 hours preceding graduation earned at MSU. Earn a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on all work completed at the University and a 2.25 on all work completed to satisfy area requirements.

General Transfer Requirements

The transfer scholarship offers \$1,500 - \$4,000 per year to new transfer students admitted to MSU having completed at least 24 hours non-developmental, college-level credit. Applicants must have at least a 3.00 cumulative college GPA. To apply, submit a completed application packet, including application form and transcripts, by June 15.
